

## LIFE AS A CHRISTIAN LUTHERAN FOCUSES ON WORSHIP TOGETHER.

Those baptized "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matt. 28:19) gather as disciples of Jesus to worship Him. Our Devotional Thoughts are a resource so that guided by the Spirit, Disciples may be made for life.

"Making Disciples for Life" includes two key nouns: disciples and life. The first weeks of the Devotionals introduce us to Jesus' 12 disciples (Matt. 10:2–4). The first disciples in this diverse group are taught by Jesus, follow Him to the cross and witness His resurrection. Jesus then commissions them to "make disciples of all nations" (Matt. 28:19). Numerous other weekly themes are organized around discipleship. Disciples of Jesus are called to confession and are assured of Jesus' forgiveness. Disciples are called and commissioned to follow Jesus always.

The resurrection of Jesus brings life to His disciples. Life is a focus of other weekly Devotionals. Christians deal with temporal realities. There is life in work, school, and extraactivities. There is life in church, school, home and neighborhood contexts. "Making Disciples for Life" addresses the reality of life in school, home and beyond. Jesus' desire is life eternal for disciples of all ages. Jesus calls us to always focus on life eternal.

The theme of disciples organizes our weekly devotional focus. The "Text" and "Theme" are based on the weekly Scripture reading. "Gathering Disciples" provides an introductory thought which connects us to the week's theme. "Teaching Disciples" shares Law and Gospel

"Teaching Disciples" shares Law and Gospel exploration of the text and, most importantly, brings Christ and His redeeming work to us.

"Praying Disciples" responds to the disciples' plea, "Teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1).

"Growing Disciples" provides opportunities for us to continue exploration and explanation of the theme beyond the Devotional setting.

A suggested section of the "Six Chief Parts" of Luther's Small Catechism is included with many of the Devotionals.

The weekly Devotional is intended to encourage us to a more deeply study the text and expand or adapt the theme and text to grow and to make disciples for life!
