"Making Disciples of All Nations" Isaiah 66:18-23

While we are all different, we are all alike in some ways. Every human, including each of us, is a sinner. God's wonderful and varied creation was ruined when Adam and Eve disobeyed God (Genesis 3). God's Word tells us, "For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:22 –23).

God immediately (Gen. 3:15) promised Adam and Eve that He would send a Savior for them and for the whole world. This year, as we hear God's Word, we will learn of God's promises throughout the Old Testament and the fulfillment of His promises in the New Testament. Jesus came to be our Savior from sin. Jesus died and rose again so that we and the whole world could be His children forever.

Our Bible passage for today shares the Prophet Isaiah's words that "all nations and tongues" (Isaiah 66:18) would see the glory of God through Jesus. Jesus would come through the family of Israel, but He would come to save the whole world

This year, we will often hear the words of Jesus from Matthew 28:19, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations." Jesus gathered His disciples and told them to "make disciples of all nations." No matter the color, culture, family background, age or anything else that demonstrates the variety of who we are, God wants us all to be part of His family, the Church. Our theme passage shares that God brings us together through our Baptism "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matt. 28:19).

This year, we will learn about a variety of people around the world. We may meet different people in our school and community. Everyone needs the Savior, Jesus. We pray that God would use us to make them His disciples.

Dear Jesus, bless all nations so that the truths of Your Word will be heard, believed and lived. Bless the missionaries who take Your Word to countries and cultures around the world. We pray that all nations will receive Your Word so that they, too, will be Your disciples forever. Amen.
