Trinity Lutheran School

"Disciple Philip"
Matthew 10:2–4; John 1:43–46;
John 12:20–26

We have learned about the first four disciples that Jesus called: Peter, Andrew, James and John. The day after they were called to follow Jesus, Jesus found Philip and said to him, "Follow me" (John 1:43). Philip immediately shared with Nathanael the excitement of meeting the One whom Moses and the prophets had written about.

We may have an interesting or important discovery to share with a friend. If they doubt our message, our response may be, "Come and see for yourself." Nathanael doubted Philip's message.

Like Nathanael, we may sometimes have doubts about Jesus and His Word. We remember Philip's invitation, "Come and see" (John 1:46). We come to God's Word to see that Jesus is the message of promise in the Old Testament. We come to God's Word to see Jesus' miracles and hear His teaching in the New Testament. We come to God's Word to see Jesus dying on the cross. We come to God's Word to see Jesus risen from the dead. We are thankful for our times of worship and our times of studying God's Word together where we can "come and see" the Jesus who called Philip and now, through our Baptism, calls us to be His disciples.

Philip was blessed to continue to see Jesus feeding the 5,000 and performing other miracles. Toward the end of Jesus' ministry (John 12:20–22), Philip was the messenger for some Greeks who wanted to see Jesus. Philip wanted everyone to see his Savior. Jesus shared with Philip and the Greeks that through His death came the promise of eternal life.

As Jesus' disciples today, we can be like Philip and say "come and see" to our family members and friends who may not have met Jesus. Through our mission offerings, we can say "come and see" to people all over the world who haven't met Jesus. With us, we want all to be disciples who "come and see" Jesus.

Jesus, thank You for the "come and see" invitation from Philip. Through Your Spirit, Your Word has invited us to come and see Your cross and empty tomb. Give us the same Spirit that led Philip to invite others to come and see the salvation You have for everyone. Amen.
