Trinity Lutheran School "Disciple Nathanael Bartholomew" Matthew 10:2–4; John 1:43–51

"You will see greater things than these.' And he said to him, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man'" JOHN 1:50B–51.

Disciple Bartholomew is called to be a disciple of Jesus. Jesus promises that by following Him, Bartholomew would see even greater things.

We are commonly known by our first and last names. Today's disciple is one of the few of whom we are given a clear first and last name. The disciple is Nathanael Bartholomew. In the Bible's listings of the disciples we have the first name in some lists and the last name in other lists.

As we learned last week, Disciple Philip introduced Nathanael to Jesus. Nathanael was under a fig tree when Jesus personally came to him. The first interaction indicates that Nathanael had been studying the Old Testament and was expecting the promised Messiah to come. He greeted the Rabbi, Teacher Jesus, "You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" (John 1:49).

Nathanael and the disciples were sinful human beings. Before his confession of faith, Nathanael had expressed his doubt and prejudice, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" (John 1:46). Sometimes our previous experiences and our personal preferences cause us to judge.

As Nathanael followed Jesus, he saw great things. He saw the amazing miracles of Jesus. He saw the greatest demonstration of love the world has ever seen. He saw Jesus die on the cross. Nathanael saw the greatest demonstration of God's power ever shown, the resurrection of Jesus

Because Nathanael saw the crucified and risen Jesus and believed in Him, He saw the greater display of Jesus' glory. Jesus would ascend into heaven. Jesus would return to glory but He would come back and welcome Nathanael and all disciples to be with Him and to see the angels of God adoring Jesus at His eternal throne. Nathanael saw Jesus and saw great things. We, too, will see the great glory of Jesus as we gather at His throne when He comes again.

Dear Jesus, like Nathanael we, too, have times of doubt. In those times, lead us to the proof and power of Your Word so that we, too, remain faithful to You for life, and like Nathanael, will be blessed to praise You on Your eternal throne of glory. Amen.
