Trinity Lutheran School "DISCIPLE THADDEUS/JUDAS, SON OF JAMES"

Matthew 10:2-4; John 14:22-27

"Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, 'Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?' Jesus answered him, 'If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him'" (JOHN 14:22–23).

From the boat or shore, an explorer sees only the ocean surface. A swimmer with diving or snorkeling equipment can look below the water's surface and see the beauty of the ocean underneath. The coral reef is home to a colorful variety of fish, sea plants and other colorful living things.

Much of what we study about the disciples is looking only at the surface. This is especially true of the last few disciples in the Gospel listings. The Bible tells us very little about James, son of Alphaeus (previous disciple); Simon, the Zealot (next week's disciple), and Thaddeus/Judas, son of James (today's disciple).

Several of the disciples have different names in different Gospel listings and contexts. Matthew and Mark tell us about disciple Thaddeus. Luke's listing and John's reference tell us about Judas, son of James. Although the names are different, they refer to the same person.

In John, Chapters 13–17, Jesus met with His disciples in the Upper Room. After Jesus washed their feet, He shared His final teachings with them before He left the Upper Room to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane. Jesus faced the trial before the High Priest, the condemnation to crucifixion by Pontius Pilate and finally the cross of Calvary.

Jesus had shown His love to the disciples daily for three years. Jesus was about to show the depth of His love by His death on the cross. "Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends" (John 15:13).

Thaddeus and the other disciples were Jesus' students. They were also His friends. Jesus would lay down His life for these friends and for the world.

Church history tells us that Thaddeus also gave his life to share the Gospel. All of the disci-

ples, except John, were martyrs — they were killed for sharing their faith.

Looking at Disciple Thaddeus is like looking at the surface of the ocean along a coral reef. We are blessed to see the depth of Jesus' love and to see the depth of the faith of the followers. When people look at us, they, too, see only the surface of who we are. As the Holy Spirit works through us, we pray that we can show others the faith that is deep inside of us. Our words and actions show the love of Jesus that God has placed in our hearts.

Dear Jesus, thank You for sharing Your love and giving Your life for Thaddeus and for us. You may not call us to give our life in witness for You, but You do call us to live a life of witness and service so that others might see Your love in and through us. Amen.


