Trinity Lutheran School "OBEDIENT DISCIPLES"

Matthew 21:1-11

"The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them. They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them" (MATT. 21:6–7).

"You better be good or you won't get anything for Christmas." While parents, teachers and others always encourage obedience, there is an added emphasis this season. A familiar secular Christmas song advises, "You better watch out, you better not cry."

We are beginning the Advent season of the church year. All the promises of the Old Testament lead to the coming of Jesus. Jesus is perfectly obedient and our response to His coming is to be believing and obedient disciples.

Advent means "coming." The church celebrates Jesus' coming as the Baby in Bethlehem, His coming to be the Savior of all nations and His coming on the Last Day. In today's Bible reading, Jesus was near the end of His earthly ministry. Jesus was coming into Jerusalem.

Jesus asked two of His disciples to help prepare for His entry into Jerusalem. The disciples obeyed their Master. They carefully followed His instructions. Jesus rode on the donkey into Jerusalem and was welcomed as the "Son of David" (Matt. 21:15). Jesus was welcomed as the One promised to the people of Israel.

Jesus perfectly obeyed His heavenly Father's plan. Jesus followed every detail of the prophecy of Zechariah (Matt. 21:4). A king would come, and the King was Jesus. During this season, most Christians are thinking mainly of Jesus' coming as the Baby in the manger in Bethlehem. While it's important to review and remember Jesus' birth, we are blessed to know and believe the rest of the story. The Baby in Bethlehem was the Son of David who went on to be designated the King of the Jews as He hung on the cross to suffer and die for us.

Jesus came and obeyed all the Old Testament prophecies so that the plan of salvation would be perfectly fulfilled. We are blessed to be baptized into Jesus' life, death and resurrection. We are blessed to see Jesus coming again on the Last Day.

Even as Jesus' disciples obeyed His directions, we are blessed to obey His commands. We obey our parents, teachers and others whom God has placed over us. We obey not in order to get presents, but because Jesus is the Present as our Savior and King. He is always present with us. The best present we can give is the Good News of Jesus as Savior. He has bought the present of salvation for us to share.

Dear Jesus, we are blessed through our Baptism to be part of Your kingdom. We confess that there are many times when we are disobedient subjects in the kingdom. We celebrate Your perfect obedience and rejoice this Advent season and always that we can come to Your throne because You have come to us. Amen.
