Trinity Lutheran School "REPENTANT DISCIPLES"

Matthew 3:1-12

"I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire" (MATT. 3:11).

"I'm sorry."

Have you ever said those words? To whom did you say them? When did you (or were you asked to) share them?

One of the important Advent voices is that of John the Baptist. John the Baptist came to prepare for and announce the coming of Jesus. In today's Bible reading, we read of John's message, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (v. 3).

John the Baptist was telling the people to say "I'm sorry." They were to be sorry for more than not getting homework done, saying a bad or hurtful word or some other failures. They were to say "I'm sorry for all my sins." "I'm sorry for not believing God's Words of promise." "I'm sorry for not obeying the commandments." John's audiences had often said the right words, but they did not do what God had told them to do.

John's message was that Jesus was coming as their Savior. Jesus was coming to suffer and die for every sinful thought, word and action for which we could ever be sorry. Jesus would come to be baptized by John the Baptist. Jesus would come as the beloved Son sent from the Father. In Jesus' Baptism He would prepare the way for our Baptism.

Our theme verse (Matt. 28:19) shares that we are made Jesus' disciples through our Baptism "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." In his Small Catechism, Martin Luther shared, "It indicates that the Old Adam in us should by daily contrition and repentance be drowned and die" (Small Catechism, Baptism, Fourth Part). Baptism drowns all of our "I'm sorry, God" sins and brings us new life.

Advent is the new season of the church year. It's a time to again say "I'm sorry," believe in Jesus' coming, rejoice in being Jesus' disciples and live in the new life we have because of Jesus' coming.

Dear Jesus, thank You for the Advent prophet, John the Baptist. May we, too, hear his call to repent from our sins. Because You have come, we hear Your voice assuring us of Your forgiveness. Bless us as we tell others about Your coming as the Savior to bring life to all. Amen.
