# Trinity Lutheran School "WORSHIPING DISCIPLES"

#### Luke 2:1-20

"And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, 'Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased,' ... And the shepherds returned glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them" (LUKE 2:13–14, 20)

#### "Christmas is ..."

Christmas is presents, decorations, family, food, lights, songs, vacation and so on. Christmas is lots of different things to many of us. Today's Bible reading (the Christmas story according to Luke, Chapter 2) teaches us that Christmas is worship. It was a time of worship for angels and shepherds.

What an amazing announcement the angel had to share with the shepherds on the field near Bethlehem: "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:11). Since the fall into sin, faithful believers had been waiting for the fulfillment of God's promise of a Savior. The Promise had been born in Bethlehem.

What was the response of the angels? The "multitude of the heavenly host" praised God. All of God's creation rejoiced at the Good News of the Savior.

The shepherds followed the angel's invitation to go to Bethlehem to see "a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger" (Luke 2:12). What was their response to what they saw? They "returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen" (v. 20). They praised God for the Savior born for them and "all nations."

A time away from school and our Christmas celebration will include lots of things to do for our families and our friends. However, our most important activity is to follow the angels' example to worship our Savior. Jesus was born to save the world from sin and to save each of us.

When we receive Christmas gifts we respond with thank you words or notes. We may give an appreciative hug to parents or grandparents who gave us a gift. How do we respond to the Gift that God has given to us? We give thanks to God with our words of praise. May God bless our worship together this Christmas time.

Dear Jesus, as we give thanks for Christmas gifts that we receive, we say "thanks" to You for the greatest gift of all. We have been given the gift of salvation because You chose to come as a humble Baby to Bethlehem. May we share our thanks this Christmas by worshiping You and following You as faithful and joyful disciples. Amen.
