Trinity Lutheran School "LEADERS FOR LIFE" Matthew 4:12–25

"And he said to them, 'Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men'" (MATT. 4:19).

In today's Bible reading, Jesus meets two sets of brothers. All of them are fishermen. While they would join Jesus at places where they might fish (rivers and lakes in the area), Jesus was not asking them to follow Him on the fishing trips that had once been part of their journeys.

For three years these disciples would follow Jesus. They would follow Him to homes, gardens, synagogues, meeting rooms, mountain tops, vineyards and many other settings. They would follow to listen, watch and learn. Jesus would ask them to follow Him all the way to Jerusalem and to the cross. They would leave behind their fishing nets and families to follow Him.

To follow Him as disciples, Jesus invited them and trained them to make disciples (fishers of men). They would not be using nets on this fishing trip; they would be using the words of Jesus.

In our Baptism, Jesus has made us His disciples. Like Simon and Andrew, James and John, we are not worthy to be His followers. Through our study of God's Word, He also leads us to the places of His ministry. Especially this Epiphany season, we see Jesus' miracles and hear His teaching. He ultimately invites us also to follow Him to His cross. Just like Jesus called fishermen, He calls students and teachers, moms and dads, pastors and factory workers and every other age and occupation. He invites us to be His faithful followers.

We follow our Leader Jesus. We invite others (even all nations) to get in line with us so that we might all follow Him to heaven. Let's follow and go fishing for Jesus!



Dear Jesus, thank You for leading Your disciples to Your cross and tomb. Lead us also to faithfully follow You and then to also be Your "fishers of men." Thank You for the Epiphany season and the times of seeing Your Light so that we might share Your glory with others. Amen
