Trinity Lutheran School "BLESSED FOR LIFE"

Matthew 5:1–12

"And he [Jesus] opened his mouth and taught them, saying: 'Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God." Matthew 5:9

"Blessed." Have you seen this word displayed in your home or some other places? What does blessed mean?

People may use or display this word because they are happy that they have a home, a family, friends or other blessings.

Long before this word was used as a decoration, it was said by Jesus. We remember that Jesus was a Teacher, a "Rabbi." Teachers in Jesus' time taught their followers, their disciples. In today's Bible reading, Jesus was teaching His disciples on a mountain. Our Bible reading is often called the Sermon on the Mount.

Nine different verses (statements) all begin with Jesus saying "blessed." Jesus doesn't say we are blessed when we have a nice house, friends, family, trophies, electronics or anything else that we might include or think of as blessings.

Jesus says, "Blessed are." We are blessed when we are followers of Jesus. We are blessed when we have Jesus as our Savior. With Jesus as our Savior, we have the things He tells His disciples about: His comfort, righteousness, mercy and peace. We are blessed because Jesus the Teacher went to the cross of Calvary to give us the blessings of forgiveness of sins, life and salvation. We are blessed because Jesus' victory is ours through His resurrection.

We are blessed to be baptized children of God. We are blessed to learn about Him in our Lutheran school, to pray to Him with our Christian families and to worship Him in our Christian church.

When we see or hear the word blessed, we celebrate that we are blessed because of Jesus! We are blessed to be His disciples to make disciples! With whom can you share your blessings?

Dear Jesus, we are blessed! We are blessed in our families. We are blessed in our school. We are blessed in our country. Best of all, we are blessed to be Your children because You have called us to be Your disciples in our Baptism. Bless our worship. Bless our serving. Bless our sharing. Amen.
