Trinity Lutheran School "ALL OF LIFE"

Matthew 5:21–37

"For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body go into hell" (MATT. 5:30).

Would you rather have a piece of candy or the bag of candy? Would you rather play one inning (quarter) or the whole game? Would you rather have one food item on your lunch plate or the whole meal?

When we believe in the Bible and the Good News of Jesus, we don't just believe part of the story. Some people would say that the Bible is only partly true. All of the Bible is God's inspired Word to us.

When it comes to the sacrifice of Jesus, He didn't just go partway to the cross. Jesus completed the whole plan of salvation. All of Jesus' body died for the sins of the world. All of Jesus' body rose again three days later.

When it comes to receiving the blessings of faith, God doesn't just give us a part. When we were baptized, we were baptized into all of Jesus' death and resurrection. We learned that Baptism "works forgiveness of sins, rescues from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe" (Small Catechism, Baptism, First Part). The whole story of salvation is for us and the entire world.

In Jesus' time, some who heard Jesus thought they could follow Jesus only partway or with part of their lives. They certainly didn't want to kill someone else, but thought it would be okay to hate them. They certainly didn't want to be unfaithful in their marriage, but thought it would be okay to have lustful thoughts. They didn't want to steal something, but thought it was okay to covet it.

Jesus gave all of Himself so that as His disciples we might have life in Him. Our response is to be faithful to Him all the time. We give Him our hearts to believe in Him, our eyes to see Him, our ears to hear Him, our hands to help others in His name. Every part of us was redeemed by Jesus so that every part of us might faithfully follow Him and serve Him as disciples as we make disciples.

Dear Jesus, so often we give part of our time and attention to You in worship and other areas of our life. You have given Your whole self for our salvation. You have forgiven all our sins. Help us to respond by giving ourselves totally as Your disciples. Amen.
