#### South Wisconsin District Financial Aid

Applications are **due May 15**. Anyone attending a Concordia University or Seminary, is a member of an LCMS congregation in the SWD and is preparing to be a full-time church worker (pastor, teacher, deaconess, DCE/DCO, DFLM, DPM, lay minister) is encouraged to apply. There are two applications required (District Financial Aid Application and Personal Aid Application). Both are available on the SWD website – <a href="swd.lcms.org/resources/student-aid-applications/">swd.lcms.org/resources/student-aid-applications/</a>.

Who may apply? Active female members of congregations of the South Wisconsin District of the LCMS who are residents of the SWD prior to college and are preparing for "full-time service in the LCMS" are encouraged to apply. An applicant must be enrolled as an undergraduate at one of the educational institutions of the Synod for the 2023-2024 school year. (Full-time service is defined as any position available through the Board of Assignments of the Synod.)

## Trinity Lutheran School "ETERNAL LIFE"

John 3:1-17

""For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (JOHN 3:16).

It's impossible to tell the beginning and end of a circle. There is no beginning and there is no end because the circle is constant and continuing. One of the characteristics (attributes) of God is that He is eternal: without beginning or end.

In Christ, God's plan for His disciples is that they would have an unending, eternal life with Him.

God's plan was that everything He created would be eternal. Adam and Eve were to live with God forever in the perfect Garden of Eden. With the fall into sin (Genesis 3), creation faced decay and Adam and Eve and all their descendants were sentenced to death. They (and we) have received the just sentence for our disobedience of God's commandments.

John 3:16 (perhaps the most familiar and loved passages in all of the Bible) tells that in His love (another attribute of God) He shared a plan of salvation for Adam and Eve and all their descendants. God loved them, all the world, you and me. God lovingly sent Jesus, His only Son, to pay the price for all sin. A previous verse (John 3:14) describes how Jesus would be "lifted up" on a cross to make it possible for us to have eternal life.

All of our lives have a beginning (our conception) and an end. We will all die. But because "God so loved the world" that He sent Jesus, He made it possible for us to have eternal life again. This eternal life is God's gift to us through faith. We can't earn this eternal life. We don't deserve eternal life. God gifts us with eternal life through faith that Jesus came to be our Savior from sin and that He alone paid the price for our sin.

Risen from the dead, Jesus reigns through all eternity. His rule over the world and His Church will never end. Through faith in Jesus, given to us in our Baptism, we are His disciples now and for all eternity.

Dear Jesus, we give thanks for the blessings of earthly life that we receive every day. We especially give You thanks for the assurance of eternal life that we have because of Your suffering and death. Continue to bless our Lenten journey and bring us to eternal life. Amen.
