

Trinity Lutheran School JOY-FULL LIFE

John 20:1–18

"Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, 'I have seen the Lord'—and that he had said these things to her" (JOHN 20:18)

Things were not joyful as the first Easter Sunday began. Matthew, Mark and Luke tell of a group of women visiting Jesus' tomb to complete the burial. John's Gospel highlights the visit of Mary Magdalene. It was not a joyful time for Mary. Her Lord and Friend, Jesus, had died, and she was visiting His tomb. When Mary found the stone rolled away from the entrance and the tomb empty, it only added to her sadness and panic, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him" (John 20:2). Even the presence of two angel messengers brought no joy to Mary.

Mary was not comforted by a voice she assumed belonged to a cemetery gardener. Again, she assumed Jesus' body had been stolen and hidden. There was no joy for Mary until she heard the voice of Jesus calling her name. Now she knew that Jesus was alive and Jesus was personally greeting her. Jesus, who had died on the cross on Good Friday and who had been in the tomb for three days, had risen from the dead. Mary heard Jesus and saw Jesus. We can imagine Mary's excited and joyful response, "I have seen the Lord" (v. 18).

In spite of joyous Easter gatherings and decorations, perhaps not everything about our Easter break or Easter day is joyful. Like Mary, we sometimes come to Easter and other times sad, frustrated or confused. Perhaps our family was not able to get together. Perhaps not everyone got along because of divorce or disagreement. Perhaps we missed a loved one who had passed away in the last year. Perhaps our family didn't have the money for new clothes or full Easter baskets. Not everything about the trimmings of

Easter is joyful.

Jesus is alive. The Jesus who stood outside the tomb and called Mary's name has called our name in our Baptism. We are baptized into His death and resurrection. The Easter Gospel tells us about Jesus who is alive and who shows Himself to us again and again in His Word. Jesus, who is alive, brings us the joy of His victory and gives us life in His Name on Easter and every day.

Dear Jesus, thank You for the joys of our Easter celebrations. Thank You for the life giving joy of Your resurrection from the dead. Give all Your disciples joy in our hearts, home and school in all seasons. May Your Spirit give us opportunities to share our joy with others so that they, too, might receive joy eternally. Amen.
