Trinity Lutheran School SIGNS OF LIFE Luke 24:13–35

"'O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" (LUKE 24:25–26).

What happens if you don't see or obey a stop sign? What happens if you don't see or obey a speed zone sign? What happens if you miss an exit marker or street sign? It's important to see and obey the signs.

Today's Bible reading tells us about two disciples traveling to Emmaus, a town a few miles from Jerusalem. Most likely they had traveled on the road a number of times and didn't need to follow any directional or other signs to get back to their home.

However, they had missed the signs (or messages) about some events in Jerusalem. They were still saddened because they thought Jesus was still dead. With His death, their hopes of a Savior were also dead.

From the beginning of time, God's Word had posted signs that a Savior would be sent into the world, that He would suffer and die and that He would rise again. Jesus Himself had often reviewed the signs and, with His miracles and messages, He had put out additional signs. Many before Jesus' time, and even during Jesus' time, had missed the signs or refused to believe in them.

Jesus came to the disciples on the road and He posted a new sign: His risen presence. The disciples heard Jesus' Word; the disciples saw Jesus' risen body; the disciples ate a meal with Jesus. The message on the signs to them was this: Jesus is alive! During the Easter season of the church year, we read again and again of the times that Jesus came to His disciples and showed them that He was alive. Many were blessed to see the signs and believe.

There are people who don't believe in Jesus or don't follow Him because they have never seen the signs in God's Word. There are people who have seen the signs, but they refuse to believe them or follow them. We thank God for the signs in His Word that we see every day in our school, the signs that we see when we worship as a church, the signs that we share as a family in our Bible reading together.

Like the disciples on the way to Emmaus, we continue to travel as Jesus' disciples. May we see and believe His signs and help others to read and follow His signs as His disciples.

Dear Jesus, throughout the Old Testament prophets posted signs of Your coming. The Gospel writers posted signs of Your human and divine being. The apostles posted signs of Your resurrection. Direct our eyes to those signs and to believe their message. As Your disciples, help us to put up signs giving witness and glory to You. Amen.
