## Trinity Lutheran School ABUNDANT LIFE John 10:1—11

"I came that they may have life and have it abundantly" (JOHN 10:10B).

The cartoonist shows Dennis the Menace surrounded by many gifts that he has been privileged to open. The cartoon shares the question of Dennis: "Is that all there is?"

Have you ever not been satisfied? Perhaps you have gotten gifts for Christmas or for your birthday and you really didn't get what you wanted or as much as you wanted. Perhaps the restaurant menu didn't have food items that you liked.

We all confess the sin of selfishness. We praise the God who so generously gives us food, clothing, family and everything we need. (We remember the explanation to the First Article of the Apostles' Creed and the explanation to the Fourth Petition of the Lord's Prayer.) While we are thankful for all blessings, we especially give thanks for an abundant life in Jesus.

Today's Bible reading is a favorite description of Jesus. Jesus described Himself as the "good shepherd" (v. 11). There were many shepherds in the area where Jesus lived and taught. Good shepherds took care of their sheep. They made sure they had plenty of grass to eat and water to drink. Good shepherds made sure the sheep were protected from wolves and other predators. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, makes sure His disciples have an abundant earthly life.

The abundance that Jesus has to give is greater than any earthly needs. Jesus said, "The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11). Only by giving His life could the Good Shepherd provide abundant life. The Good Shepherd was also the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

Because of the Shepherd's sacrifice and because of the Shepherd's resurrection, we, by faith, have an abundant life. We have our sins forgiven. We have the promise of eternal life with Jesus. No matter how abundant our life is in things and comforts, no matter how sparse our life is in things and comforts, we have an abundant life now and forever in Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

Having received an abundance of God's grace, we are commissioned to share His abundant life with others. There is plenty of grace from the Shepherd to be shared!

Jesus, we confess that often we think and live in the poverty of our selfishness rather than in the abundance of Your grace. Through our Baptism the promises of an abundance of spiritual blessings have been given to us. As Your disciples may we share the abundant life with others so all may share in Your eternal blessings. Amen.
