#### HELP FOR LIFE John 14:15–21

"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth" (JOHN 14:16–17A).

Jesus was a Rabbi (Teacher) for His disciples. Near the end of His earthly life, Jesus was still teaching as described last week, Jesus was teaching His disciples in a room in Jerusalem, only hours before He goes to the Garden of Gethsemane to be betrayed, to the court rooms to be tried and sentenced to death, and then to the cross to die for the sins of the world.

Jesus had also been the Helper for His disciples. Jesus helped them when they thought they were going to die on the stormy sea. Jesus helped them when they were hungry. Jesus helped them when they grieved the death of their friend Lazarus. Jesus helped them with their questions.

Most importantly, through His teaching and miracles, Jesus helped them see and believe that He was the Savior that had been promised. In the hours and weeks ahead, Jesus would help them see that by His death the sacrifice was complete and that by His resurrection He had conquered death and the grave.

Jesus shared with His disciples that His mission on earth was about to be completed and that He would be leaving them. If Jesus was no longer with them, who would be their helper?

Jesus promised that He would send the Holy Spirit as "another Helper" (John 4:16). The Spirit would continue to help them see and believe in the sacrifice of Jesus. The Spirit would help them to remember and believe in Jesus' resurrection from the dead. The Spirit would help the disciples to continue to faithfully follow Jesus.

While we thank God for all the helpers He gives us, we, too, are thankful for the Spirit Helper. The Spirit helps us remember our Baptism and God's promises through our Baptism. The Spirit helps us remember the truth of

God's Word. The Spirit helps us remember the importance of learning and living God's Word. The Spirit helps us invite others to see Jesus, the Helper for all disciples.

Dear Jesus, thank You for the helpers in our lives — parents, teachers, community leaders, health workers and many others. Thank You for sending the Holy Spirit as our salvation Helper. Through the Spirit we count the blessings of Baptism. Thank You for the Word which helps us live as Your disciples. Use us to help others. Amen.
