Trinity Lutheran School PATH TO LIFE Acts 2:14a, 22-28

"You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence" (ACTS 2:28).

Where does your favorite path take you? There are many kinds of paths through many different areas. There are paths through a garden or forest, steep and winding paths up a mountain or other nature routes. There may be the favorite neighborhood path to the library or to the park. There is only one path to life with Jesus.

Today's Bible lesson continues with Peter's Pentecost sermon. Peter shared the inspired words of King David, "You have made known to me the paths of life" (Acts 2:28). King David had walked the paths of Bethlehem's hills as a shepherd boy. King David had walked the paths of the king's courtyard. King David had walked on paths away from God as he had lied, cheated and committed adultery. God, in His grace, had shared the promise of the Savior who would come from the family of David. Believing that promise, David was also put on the path to life eternal. Apostle Peter had walked with Jesus on the path of His earthly ministry. Peter had walked on paths of denying Jesus and doubting Him. Peter was blessed to see Jesus who was crucified and alive again. Through the Holy Spirit, Peter was put on the path to life.

Peter's audience had been on paths of unbelief and some even on the path to murder Jesus. Peter's proclamation of Jesus' resurrection invited them to the path of life. Those who believed in Jesus and who walked in faith with Jesus to His death and resurrection would be on the path to life with Jesus forever. There is only one path and only one way onto the path with Jesus.

This week, the church celebrates that God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We are blessed to celebrate that we were put on the path to life in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit in our Baptism. The three persons of the Trinity keep us on the path so that we can faithfully stay on the path to eternal life. We invite others to be disciples on Jesus' path.

Dear Holy Jesus, we rejoice in Your unity with the Holy Father and Holy Spirit. Thank You for bringing the work of the Trinity to us in our Baptism. May we praise the Holy Trinity in our worship now and with the three persons for all eternity. May we continue to make disciples in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
