Matthew 9:9 - "As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and he said to him. 'Follow me.' And he rose and followed him." Trinity Lutheran School Healing For Life Matthew 9:9–13

"'Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. Go and learn what this means, "I desire mercy, and not sacrifice." For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners'" (MATT. 9:12–13).

Jesus healed the sick. Matthew's Gospel tells of Jesus healing Peter's mother-inlaw when she was sick. Jesus healed some who were sick with leprosy. Jesus had the power to heal any and all illnesses.

Jesus called Matthew to be one of His disciples. Before he became one of Jesus' disciples, Matthew had been sick. Matthew and other tax collectors were not sick with leprosy or any other diseases of Jesus' day. Matthew and others were sick in sin.

While all diseases are a result of a sin coming into the world, sin doesn't necessarily affect our mind, skin, bones or other parts of our body. Sin affects our whole being. There is no human cure for the disease of sin. The disease of sin always leads to death.

We thank God for doctors, hospitals and clinics that help heal our bodies. However, there is only one Physician (Doctor) who can cure us from sin. Jesus is the cure. Jesus brought healing by paying for our cure with His death on the cross. Jesus, who brought healing and life to Disciple Matthew, brings healing and life to us.

Even as disciples we will still face diseases during our earthly life. We look forward to being cured from all diseases when we and all disciples are with Jesus eternally.

Dear Jesus, we confess that we were born with the sickness of sin and continue to feel the effects of the disease of sin. You came to cleanse us from our sin and have made us pure and righteous disciples through Your blood. Help us to be witnesses to Your work as the perfect Physician. Amen.
