It is that time of year again when our hearts and minds are turned to remembering those neighbors who are less fortunate. For more than 75 years LWR has responded to war, disasters, and emergencies by turning the compassion of quilters and school and health kit makers into tangible items that meet urgent needs and offer glimpses of hope for families experiencing crisis. Your Trinity Ladies Aid/LWML has organized this drive here at Trinity for many years. Please pray about this and, if so moved, we would ask you to consider donating items for the school kits or personal care kits. Your generosity will certainly be a blessing to the receiving individuals and blessed by Him. We have completed an inventory of items we had already collected last year or during the interim. The following need numbers take this into consideration.

GOAL FOR 2023:

Our goal is to make <u>100 school kits</u> and <u>100 personal care kits</u>. Our dedicated quilters are nearing their goal of <u>50 twin size tied quilts</u>.

To complete 100 personal care/health kits we will need the following:

- 7 bath size bars of soap in wrapper
- 80 adult size toothbrushes in the original package

To complete 100 school kits, we will need the following:

- 98-70 sheet notebooks, narrow or wide lined
- 7 small handheld pencil sharpeners
- 53 blunt scissors
- 53 black or blue ballpoint pens
