TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

Whose Connected?
Matthew 22:1–14

"Go therefore to the main roads and invite to the wedding feast as many as you find.' And those servants went out into the roads and gathered all whom they found, both bad and good. So the wedding hall was filled with guests" (Matt. 22:9–10).

A contact list gives helpful information in case we need to contact someone in an emergency or to share information. Jesus wants everyone to be in contact with Him.

Jesus shared another parable about His kingdom. We don't know how or why the king chose the "contacts," or guests, for the wedding feast for his son. Weddings in Jesus' time were often very big (especially for a king), and the celebration lasted for many days. In this parable, the guests who were contacted ignored the invitation from the king. The king then shared the invitation to the wedding with "as many as you find" (Matt. 22:9).

Jesus' story emphasizes who is invited into His kingdom. Jesus' kingdom is not like a wedding, where the guest list is limited. Jesus invites everyone to come into His kingdom. The parable also shares the sad news that many ignore Jesus' invitation, and even some who come don't believe in the blessings that Jesus has to give.

We praise God that we are on His "contact" list. Jesus contacted us in our Baptism. As we are welcomed to His banquet, our King dresses us properly. In our Baptism, we receive the "wedding garment" of Jesus' righteousness. Our sins are covered by the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Just as the king sent his servants out to invite others to the feast, we are invited by our King to share the invitation to Jesus' kingdom. When we invite friends to a party, our parents may ask that we only invite a certain number. Jesus has not set number limitations to His heavenly celebration. Everyone is invited.

Because Jesus has put us on His contact list, we have the privilege of staying in contact with Him every day in prayer.

PRAYER

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for parents, teachers and others, who were Your means to put us in contact with You. We ask that You keep us connected and bless us as we contact others so that they too can be part of the heavenly banquet. Amen.
