

Who's Connected? Matthew 22:15–22

"Therefore render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's" (Matt. 22:21).

The U.S. Constitution has three branches of government. The executive branch (the president) is connected to the legislative branch (Congress), which is connected to the judicial branch (Supreme Court). These connections are important for keeping our country strong and free.

The government in Jesus' time was much different. The Roman Empire, led by emperor Caesar Augustus, controlled everything. Many of the Jews did not like being under the control of this government. The Roman government was often not fair to the citizens in asking them to pay many taxes. Jesus is asked, "What should be our connection to this government?"

Jesus answered, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's" (Matt. 22:21). Unless the government demands that we disobey God (Acts 5:29), we should obey and respect the government's laws.

Jesus also said that we are to render "to God the things that are God's" (Matt. 22:21). The most important connection is God's connection to us. God has provided all things for us. He has given us a "good government" and many other blessings (Luther's Explanation to Fourth Petition). However, the greatest blessing we receive is not the freedom of our country and good government, but the salvation that God has given us. God has given us His Son so that we might be free from sin, death and the devil.

For the blessing of our salvation, we render to God our thanks and praise in worship. We render our obedience to His will, including respect for our government. When there are laws that do not honor God and are not true to His Word, as Christians we contact those who make the law and remind them of God's plan for His people.

While we thank God for the freedoms that we have in our country, we pray for those in other places in the world where the government and rulers do not treat all people fairly.

God's will is for us to live at peace in His world. God's ultimate will is that we will have His peace in Jesus forever.

Jesus, thank You for the freedom from sin that we have through You. Thank You for the freedoms in our country. We ask that we may be faithful and law-abiding citizens and seek Your will in all things. Amen.
