TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

Connected By Grace Psalm 46

"The Lord of hosts is with us: the God of Jacob is our fortress" (Psalm 46:11).

History connects us to the past. Last week we reflected on the history of our country. It is important to learn history — the history of the world, the history of our country and community, the history of our family and especially the history of our church.

The Reformation celebration connects us to the history of our Lutheran church.

The Bible is a history book which tells how God works through all of history. Through God's Spirit-inspired authors, we read of God's plan to save us from sin. In the Old Testament history, God makes His saving promises to Adam and Eve and repeats His promises to patriarchs and prophets. In New Testament history, we read how Jesus came to fulfill all of God's promises. Jesus was part of the history of the world. But most importantly, His historical life, death and resurrection saved the world from sin.

Many times during the history of the world, people have forgotten the Bible and the history of God's plan to save us. The time before and during Martin Luther's life was one of the "dark" times. But God did not forget His people. He worked through Luther and other reformers to once again make the Gospel known in the church.

Luther believed in the promise of Psalm 46: "The Lord of hosts is with us." Even though the government and the church made it very difficult for Luther to share the truth of God's Word, he did not despair. Luther courageously shared the Gospel: that God in His grace sent His Son to die for us, and that God's blessings are not to be bought or earned, but simply received, by faith.

As we learn about history, we celebrate that God continues to be at work through His Word. "The Lord of hosts is with us" (Psalm 46:11). God continues to be with us, sharing His grace in our Baptism and His Word.

We have an exciting Reformation history to learn, live and share.

PRAYER

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for the truth of Your Word which brings us salvation. Thank You for your servant, Martin Luther, and others who continued to teach the truth. We ask that we might be true to You at all times. Amen.
