Connected To the Giver Psalm 67

"The earth has yielded its increase; God, our God, shall bless us. God shall bless us; let all the ends of the earth fear him!" (Psalm 67:6–7).

Why do magnets connect to some surfaces, like metal, but not to others?

God has connected Himself to us in an even more magnificent way than a magnet connects to a surface. In our Baptism, God has connected Himself to us. By our own choices, we would push away from Him, but He brings us in and holds us firm.

Like a magnet that pulls in other objects, God in His grace has brought many blessings to us. The most important blessing is our salvation through Jesus. God has pulled us to Himself so that we are connected to Him every day and in every way. We know that by faith we will be connected to Him forever.

If we look around, we see that God has also surrounded us with many other blessings. Again, we don't deserve those blessings, but God gives us much more than what we deserve or earn (First Article of Apostles' Creed). Thanksgiving is a time to give thanks to God for all that He has given us.

Thanksgiving is also a good time to be a "magnet" for food, clothing or other items that we collect for charity.

It is God's will that everyone knows Him as Creator and Redeemer and praise Him. Our Psalm verse says, "Let all the ends of the earth praise him" (Psalm 67:7). Let's come together to worship as a school, as families and as a community. We look forward to gathering together around God's throne to give Him thanks eternally.

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for all that You have given us. We are especially thankful for the gift of faith. We ask that You give us generous hearts to share with others. Amen.
