Connected To Others Matthew 25:31-46

"And the King will answer them. 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me" (Matt. 25:40).

Jesus, who suffered, died and rose again, ascended into heaven. Jesus, the King, sits on His heavenly throne of glory. From that throne, Jesus will come again to earth on the Last Day. Jesus will come to judge the world. The last Sunday in the Church Year typically celebrates Christ as our King.

The King is also the Judge. Jesus will separate the believers from the unbelievers. Those who have rejected Jesus will be separated from Him forever in hell. It is important that everyone hears about Jesus, their Savior from sin, and believes in Him.

Jesus' return does not need to frighten us. We are blessed to be baptized children of God. We are blessed to have heard God's Word and believe in our Savior. Jesus does not come to condemn us but to welcome us to be with Him.

While faith in Jesus saves us, our faith is shown by the actions of love and care that we do in His name. When we help others in Jesus' name, we show His love. The Bible's description of Jesus' return tells us that God's faithful people wait for His return by feeding the hungry, visiting the sick and helping others.

God uses us to share His love. As students in a Lutheran school, God can use us. Every day, we have the opportunity to be kind to one another, especially to someone who may be sad or hurting. Perhaps we can reach out to others in church who are sick and lonely. Beyond the school, we can reach out in our community by offering food and clothing.

As we help others in Jesus' name, we too are privileged to hear Jesus say, "As you did

it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it for me" (Matt. 25:40).
