TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

Creatively Connected Isaiah 64:1–9

"But now, O Lord, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are the work of your hands" (Isaiah 64:9).

Art is important in our school. Different types of art connect different types of materials. A painting connects colors to a canvas or page. Metal, clay, paper or other materials are connected to form a sculpture.

Isaiah was a prophet, not an artist. Isaiah was one of the many prophets God sent to His people to call them to repent of their sins. Isaiah was also God's messenger to share the Good News that God would send His Son to save them from their sins.

Isaiah describes God as an artist. "You are our potter; we are the work of your hands" (Isaiah 64:9). At the beginning of time, God artistically created everything as He spoke the words, "Let there be ..." Everything was perfect, including God's creation of human beings. Like someone smashing a sculpture or ruining a painting, the devil's temptation ruined everything God had made.

God would not leave His creation ruined. God the artist formed a "new creation" through Christ (2 Cor. 5:17). God was building the cross on which His Son would die since His first promise to Adam and Eve. Isaiah was blessed to share the promise of what God was going to do. We are blessed to see the completion of what God has done.

In Christ, God now sees us as His beautiful creation. In our Baptism, we are His new creation. We are created to praise and serve Him.

Advent is a special time in the Church Year. We see the beauty and art of the season in Christmas decorations and bright lights. In the church, we see something even more beautiful than the Advent wreath or other special seasonal decorations. We see the beauty of God's plan of salvation. All the promises of a Savior come together to give us a beautiful sculpture of God's eternal plan for us.

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, we rejoice in Your coming to earth. Thank You for Your work in us. We ask Your blessing on our Advent gatherings in our church, school and home. Prepare us for Your coming! Amen.
