Connecting Bridges Isaiah 40:1-11

"A voice cries, 'In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God" (Isaiah 40:3).

"Why are bridges important? What do bridges connect?"

The Old Testament prophets were like bridges. Prophets like Isaiah connected God and His will with the people. Often, God's people became disconnected from God. They forgot God and worshipped idols instead. Prophets were sent to tell God's people, "You are disconnected from God, and you will be lost forever."

Prophets also reconnected God's people with His promise to save them. Since our fall into sin, God had promised to send His Son to be our Savior. We are about to celebrate Jesus' birth again.

Isaiah had made a prophecy about a voice crying in the wilderness. This voice is that of John the Baptist, another prophet. John the Baptist introduced Jesus to the people who came out to hear him (Mark 1:1–8). John was a bridge to Jesus. John emphasized that his role was to let the people in his day know that the Messiah was finally here.

We are blessed to know and believe that Jesus came to be our Savior. Because of Jesus' birth, the bridge to heaven has been built. When Jesus comes again on the Last Day, we will be blessed to be with Him forever.

Just as Isaiah and John were bridges to Jesus, we can become a "bridge" connecting other people to Jesus. It is a great time to tell others that Jesus was born for them and invite them to come to church to learn more about Him this Christmas season.

PRAYER

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for prophets who were the bridge from the Old Testament to the New Testament. Help me to be Your bridge connecting my family and friends to You. Amen.
