Marriage Connections Isaiah 61:1-11

"I will greatly rejoice in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with beautiful headdress, and a bride adorns herself with jewels" (Isaiah 61:10).

"The marriage connection is special to God. In the Garden of Eden, God united man and woman and called them "one flesh" (Gen. 2:24). God continues to bless the connection of marriage.

All human connections are affected by sin. Marriage is also affected by sin. In some of our own families, the marriage connection breaks and families are separated or divorced.

Jesus' coming brings forgiveness and help to all relationships. The prophet Isaiah tells of a relationship between a bride and bridegroom that will bring joy to all people. Jesus is pictured as the perfect Bridegroom who comes to meet His bride, the church.

Jesus was born in Bethlehem, suffered and died, and rose again. Through His saving work, Jesus, the Bridegroom, took the church as His bride. We are dressed to meet our Bridegroom in the white robe of righteousness we received in our Baptism. As members of the church, we are in a "marriage" with Jesus, our Bridegroom. We look forward to the final and perfect celebration of this marriage on the Last Day. The Apostle John describes that day of the final Advent (Rev. 21:1–4).

Advent is a time when we remember Jesus' coming in Bethlehem. It is also a time when we celebrate that Jesus will come again. It will be like a perfect wedding day where there will be joy eternally. We will all be at that wedding celebration!
