Connected Through Traditions Luke 2:22-40

"And there was a prophetess, Anna ... She did not depart from the temple, worshiping with fasting and prayer night and day. And coming up at that very hour she began to give thanks to God and to speak of him to all who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem" (Luke 2:36–38).

Traditions are important. Traditions connect us to the blessings of the past and make connections for the future. Some traditions that may be part of your family or school life— "Every year we ..." "Every summer we ..."

This week's Bible lesson includes several "traditions." The religious laws of Jesus' time required parents to bring their baby to the temple for special blessings. Mary and Joseph were faithful in keeping all that God commanded of His chosen people. They brought their infant Son, Jesus, to the temple.

Anna was a member of God's family. Her "traditions" included regularly worshipping, fasting and praying at the temple. God blessed Anna's faithfulness. Like another faithful worshipper, Simeon, Anna got to see Mary and Joseph bring Jesus to the temple. Anna got to see her Savior. Anna gave thanks to God for the gift that He had given to her and to the world.

Our Christmas worship once again shared the Good News of Jesus' birth. The Savior that Anna saw in the temple is the Savior whom we see in God's Word. Like Anna, we praise God for His gift of salvation.

There are many traditions that go with our Christmas celebrations. We may have certain foods that we eat, family gatherings that we enjoy or decorations that we display. Those traditions are enjoyable and important.

The traditions that are most important are those that help us remember the birth of Jesus and lead us to worship Him. Christmas traditions in the church, such as the lighting of candles on Christmas Eve, putting white cloths on the altar on Christmas Day, lighting

the Christ candle and reading Luke 2, point us again and again to Jesus, the reason for our celebration.

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for Your appearance to prophetess Anna. Thank You for the Word that brings Your appearance to us. We ask that You would bless us with traditions that bring to our mind Your birth and our salvation. Amen.
