TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

Family Connection Mark 1:4-11

"And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (Mark 1:11).

What do these connections have in common: father and son, mother and daughter, brother and sister, grandparent and grandchild? Many times, our family connections are those most precious to us.

Today's Bible reading is an important event in Jesus' life. After growing up in Nazareth, Jesus is now ready to begin His earthly ministry. (Note: Jesus is 30 years old when He begins His earthly ministry.) Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. In that setting, we learn about an important connection. The voice from heaven announces, "This is my beloved Son."

The voice is God the Father's. (Remember that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are present at Jesus' Baptism.) God the Father chose to send His "beloved" Son, Jesus, into the world to save us from our sins.

While we celebrate family connections, we also know that our family connections are often strained or broken; parents get divorced, brothers and sisters disagree. There are many examples in the Bible of disconnections in families: Cain killed his brother Abel; Joseph's brothers sold him to the Egyptians; Absalom tried to steal the kingdom from his father, David. We are all members of sinful families.

God chose to send His only Son to pay for the sins of family conflicts and divisions. Only the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross could pay for our sins. The Father was "pleased" to send His Son so that we might be His children again (Mark 1:11).

Jesus' Baptism also reminds us of the importance of our Baptism. In our sin, we were separated from God's family. Through Baptism, God connects us into His family again. Through the blessings of Jesus' suffering and death, God now sees us as His child and says, "This is my beloved son, daughter, parent, grandparent. ..."

We are blessed with loving connections in our families and in our church families. We are connected to the perfect love of our Heavenly Father.

PRAYER

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for connecting us to You and to our Heavenly Father through Baptism. We ask that You strengthen our connection to You and the family of the church. Amen.
