#### TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

Sharing Connections John 1:43–51

"Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph'" (John 1:45).

Our Bible story for today tells of Jesus making the first connections with His disciples. Earlier, Jesus had called four fishermen — brothers James and John and brothers Peter and Andrew. Jesus called Philip next and tells him to "Follow me" (John 1:43).

Philip invites Nathanael to come and see "Him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph" (John 1:45). Nathanael saw Jesus and believed with Philip that He was the fulfillment of all the Old Testament prophecies.

Like a row of falling dominos, the sins of Adam and Eve had been passed down from one generation to another. This connection also reaches us. We are all sinful. We have fallen because of the sins of our ancestors, and our sins cause our descendants to fall.

God set up a new connection with fallen sinners. He passed on His promises through the patriarchs and the prophets. Nathanael and Phillip and all the disciples saw that God's promises were fulfilled in Jesus. They followed Jesus and witnessed his death and resurrection.

The Good News of Jesus has been passed on to us in our Baptism and through God's Word. What Jesus started — through His earthly ministry, suffering, death and resurrection — has connected to us. We now praise and thank Him.

Like Nathanael, we have the privilege of passing this message on to others. We can say to our family, friends, neighbors and the world, "Come and see." Who can you connect with the Good News of Jesus?

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask what □ ever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7). Jesus, we thank You for connecting us to the message that You are Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of Joseph and the Son of God. We ask that we may be the means to connect others to the Good News of salvation. Amen. strengthen our connection to You and the family of the church. Amen.
