


INTROIT










SALUTATION and COLLECT OF THE DAY


EPISTLE ~ 1 John 3:-1-3

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.








The Proper Preface approperiate to the day or season is spoken.






