Introducing Trinity's Second Annual 100 Mile Club!

Who: Any Trinity student in grades 3-8

When: May, June, July, and August (Running club days count!)

Where: Anywhere! Outside or inside on a treadmill or in a gym

Why: Earn toe tokens (J) and a t-shirt when you reach the goal of 100 miles! Plus, you'll get in shape and begin/maintain a healthy habit!

How: Record your miles on the attached Running Log. When you reach 10, 20, 30, etc. miles, send Pastor GeRue an email (kgerue@trinitymenasha.com), and he'll make sure you

get your toe tokens! When you reach 100 miles, there will be a t-shirt waiting for you! Toe Tokens can be tied to your shoelaces, attached to your backpack, put on a necklace, made into a bracelet, etc. Miles must be walked or ran, recorded on the Running Log, and verified with a parent signature.

How do I know how far I've gone? Websites such as <http://onthegomap.com> will allow you to map out exactly where you ran and how far it was! How fun is that?!? Treadmills will track your miles for you. Also, if you live near a high school track, one lap is $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile (4 laps per mile).
