Band Demonstration

On Tuesday September 11th, Mr. Orth our band teacher will be giving demonstrations of various band instruments to students in grades 4-8. If your child is interested in learning to play a band instrument, please let them know to come to our demonstration. Mr. Orth will be demonstrating the following instruments: Flute, Clarinet, Alto Sax, Trumpet, Trombone, and Percussion. Lessons are \$15 per lesson, and students will meet weekly with Mr. Orth for their lesson. You can rent to own instruments at a very reasonable price from Heid Music and I believe Island music offers a similar program. Please let Mr. Dahms know if you have any questions, as I have had a child who has completed lessons at Trinity and it now in the Symphonic Band in High School, and this was a great foundation to build from for those who desire to play an instrument.
