Thank you for your continued support of our SCRIP program.

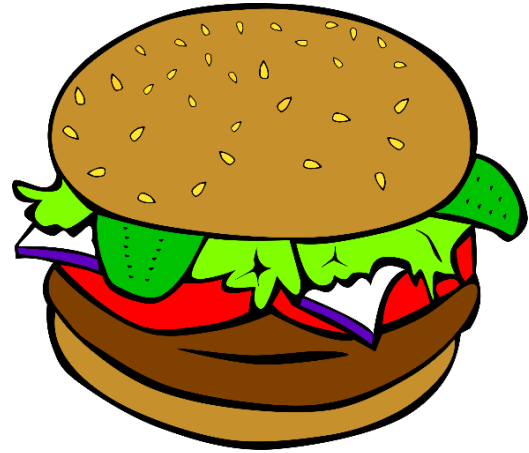
