Cruise the Fox River!

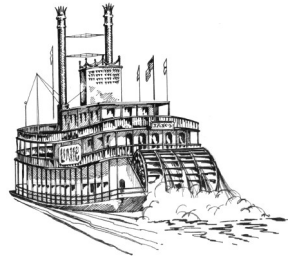
Thursday, July 22, 2021 • 4:00 pm
