Trinity Lutheran School "STOP, LOOK AND LISTEN FOR LIFE"

Matthew 17:1-9

He was still speaking when, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." Matthew 17:5

"Stop, Look and Listen" can describe the three disciples' experiences as they arrived at a crossroad in Jesus' ministry. Those words also direct our review of the Transfiguration and the journey to life that we are blessed to receive.

The Transfiguration is an important crossroads in the church year. The Epiphany season follows the Christmas celebration. For the past weeks, the church has followed Jesus on His earthly ministry. The disciples have heard Jesus' teachings and seen His miracles. Jesus has revealed Himself to them as the Son of God. The church will now transition to the Lenten season of the church year.

Three disciples — Peter, James and John — were chosen to join Jesus on the Mount of Transfiguration. The disciples were privileged to have a special look at Jesus. Our reading tells us that "his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light." This was a look at the glory of God that few, like Moses and Elijah, had been privileged to see. They saw the full glory of Jesus.

The disciples were privileged to listen to the words about Jesus. The voice declared, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Matt. 17:5). The Father's voice that had greeted Jesus at His baptism now spoke again, sharing the truth about Jesus at this intersection of His ministry.

Jesus gave all of Himself so that as His disciples we might have life in Him. Our response is to be faithful to Him all the time. We give Him our hearts to believe in Him, our eyes to see Him, our ears to hear Him, our hands to help others in His name. Every part of us was redeemed by Jesus so that every part of us might faithfully follow Him and serve Him as disciples as we make disciples.

Dear Jesus, so often we give part of our time and attention to You in worship and other areas of our life. You have given Your whole self for our salvation. You have forgiven all our sins. Help us to respond by giving ourselves totally as Your disciples. Amen.
