TRINITY LUTHERAN SCHOOL

A Connection of Talents Matthew 25:14-30

"Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master" (Matt. 25:23).

Have you ever played Connect 4? What's the goal of the game? What connections do you make to win the game?

The Bible stories last week and today teach about Jesus' return on the Last Day. It is an important lesson because Jesus will come again, and we should be ready and waiting in faith.

Today's Bible reading tells us what to do while we wait for Jesus' return. We don't just play games while we wait. The Good News is that we wait confidently connected to Jesus. Jesus connects us in Baptism to Himself through His death and resurrection (Rom. 6). Jesus keeps us connected through His Word.

We wait connected by the Spirit to the church. In the church, God gives talents to connect us to Him and one another and to bless His church. Jesus' parable teaches that each of us receives talents to use.

Sometimes we may think, "I am not good at anything!" We may compare ourselves to others and think, "I wish I had some of the abilities that my friends or classmates have." Every child of God has received talents from Him. Our talents may be different from others, but they are still God-given and important. Perhaps our teachers, our parents or others can help us see the gifts that God has given to us.

Sometimes we may also get selfish or lazy and not use the talents God has given us. We pray that God would have us see the opportunities we have to serve Him and others.

When all the pieces in Connect 4 line up, there is a winner. When all the talents of God's people line up, people are blessed, and our God is glorified.

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).

Jesus, thank You for the gift of the Spirit and the talents that we have been given. We ask that You open our hearts, eyes and ears to the opportunities You give to serve others. Amen.
