Matthew 9:9 – *"As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and he said to him, 'Follow me.' 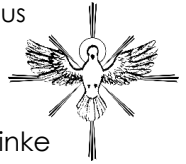
SUMMER MID-WEEK DIVINE SERVICES WILL CONTINUE

Trinity Test Scores from NWEA MAP Testing

In Growth for Language Usage Trinity is overall Nationwide in the 67th Percentile. That means 67% of schools test below Trinity in Language Usage. This is a 1% increase over the 2025 testing.

25% of our students are in the 81 and above percentile

In Growth for Reading Trinity is overall Nationwide in the 64th Percentile. That means 64% of schools test below Trinity in Reading. This is a 8% increase over the 2025 testing.

29% of our students are in the 81 and above percentile

In Growth for Math Trinity is overall Nationwide in the 52nd Percentile. That means 52% of schools test below Trinity in Math. This is a 8% increase over the 2025 testing.

10% of our students are in the 81 and above percentile
