The Trinity SCRIP program is the greatest tool for tuition reduction. Scrip is available all day through the Church and School office, as well as before school. For your purchases you can earn 75% of the scrip profit back to reduce your tuition. ## Medications and Health Notes

Just a reminder that children must be fever free for 24 hours before coming to school after they have been sick.

If your child needs medication, you must fill out a consent form in the office for us to administer medicine to your child. We do not keep any medicine on hand, including cough drops, as we need parental consent to issue all medications and cough drops. Any medication left to dispense should come in its original container with all of the pertinent information listed in case we have any questions.
